Discussion Questions:

1. Look at Garfield's face in frames 1 and 2. What do his facial expressions tell you about what he is thinking?
2. Look at Garfield's face in frame 3. How does his expression change?
3. How does Garfield's attitude about birthdays change from frame 1 to frame 3? Why does it change? What does Garfield realize?



Discussion Questions:

1. What does Garfield mean by, "Forgot to let go again?"
2. Garfield says that Odie forgot to let go again. "Again" is an important clue. What does it tell you about past events in Odie's life?
3. If you had to describe Odie, based on this comic, how might you describe him?



Discussion Questions:

1. What is going through Garfield's mind right here?
2. What is Garfield doing in the last frame? Why?
3. Do you think Garfield is a smart cat? Why or why not?



Discussion Questions:

1. Look at frame 1. What does "Beedle, Beedle, Beedle," mean?
2. Who is Liz?
3. Look at Jon's expression in frame 6. How does he look? Why?
4. Why is Garfield saying "Uh-oh" in the last frame?
